Subject: School Re-opening for Face to Face learning

Dear Parent,

Please note that the school will be opening for students who have opted for Face to Face learning with effect from Sunday 27th Sept 2020 keeping in mind the gradual return of students as per the following schedule:

Week 1	
27th September to 1st October 2020	
Sunday	Grade 6 , 7 & 8
Monday	Grade 8
Thursday	Grade 6, 7 & 8

Week 2	
4th October to 8th October 2020	
Sunday	Grade 5, 6 , 7 & 8
Monday	Grade 4, 5 & 8
Wednesday	Grade 4
Thursday	Grade 6, 7 & 8

Week 3	
11th October 2020 onwards	
Sunday	Grade 5, 6 , 7 & 8
Monday	Grade 4, 5 & 8
Tuesday	Grade 1, 2 & 3 (Group 1 - Arabs)
Wednesday	Grade 1, 2 & 3 (Group 2 – Non Arabs) & Grade 4
Thursday	Grade 6, 7 & 8

Students who have opted for Face to Face learning will continue with distance learning for the remaining days of the week as per the prescribed DL time table.

We request you to strictly adhere to the following protocols regarding Reopening School for Face to Face learning module:

- The school timing for Face to Face learning module will be from 8:45 am to 1:00 pm.
- All students attending school will disperse at 1:00 pm and parents should ensure that their child is picked-up from the school latest by 1:15 pm.
- Any student/ family member staying with him/her who travelled (in the last 14 days) must adhere to UAE authority requirements, including any self-isolation and testing

requirements. Online Travel Disclosure Forms must be submitted through the school portal before joining the school. (Form is enclosed with this circular)

- **The child/children of 12 years and above must undergo the mandatory COVID-19 test and the result must be negative. Submit the test report to the school through the school portal prior to joining the school.**
- **Students below 6 years (below Grade 1) are not required to wear masks.**
- **Students of Grade 1 and above are required to bring a minimum of two (2) masks each school per day, for their personal use.**
- **Commitment to a complete physical distance of 2m in the corridors, and a 1.5m inside the classes.**
- **Parents cannot enter the school premises.**
- **There will be assigned areas for parents in the morning at the designated gate, where the temperature of students will be checked before they enter the school.**
- **People with compromised medical conditions, including the elderly, should not come for drop-off and/or pick-up.**
- **Only one parent/guardian is allowed for drop-off and/or pick-up of his/her child at the designated points and designated timings with no interaction inside the school.**
- **Parent/guardian will be given a maximum time limit of 10 minutes in the designated area to pick-up/drop-off with no crowding, maintenance of 1.5 meters distance and wearing masks always.**
- **Students must bring healthy food and water from home and are not allowed to share it with others.**
- **Face shields are encouraged during meal-breaks when the masks are temporarily removed.**
- **Children should be kept at home if they are generally unwell and ensure the submission of the medical report from any authorized medical practitioner before resuming the classes.**
