*FS1 & Year 1 students of SPS dressed up as their favourite characters from the books they love. They showed their creativity and their love for reading.*



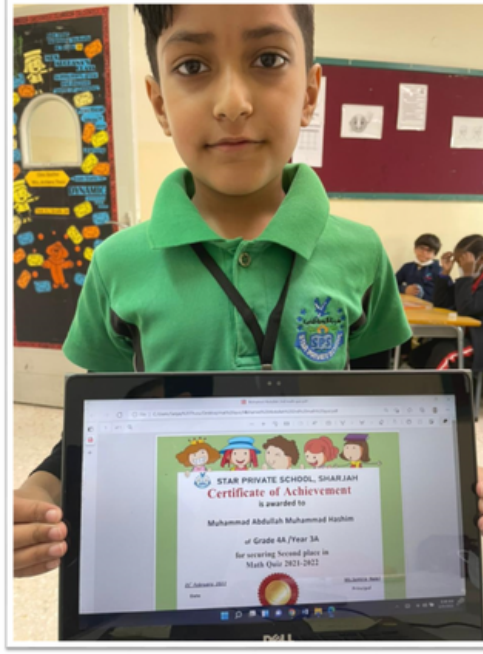
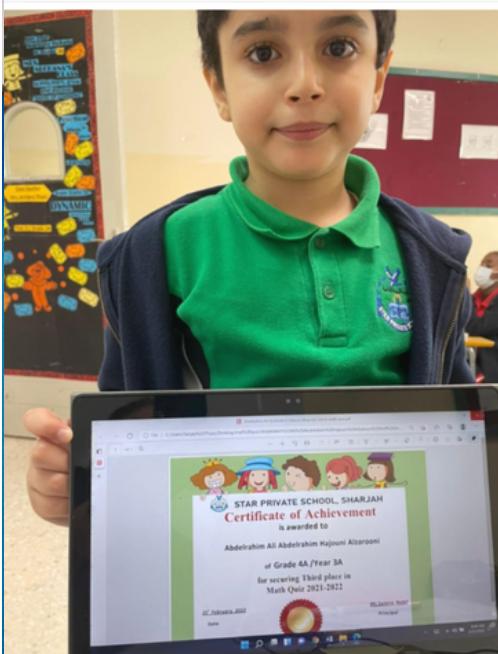
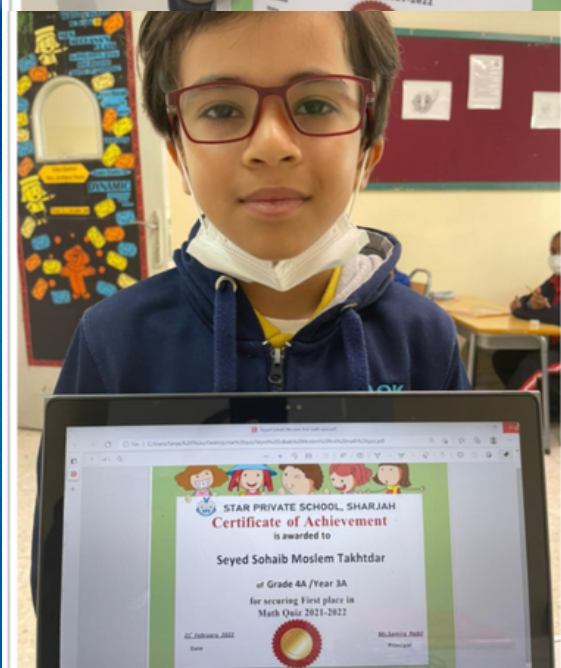


# MATH QUIZ WINNERS

# STORY TELLING COMPETITION

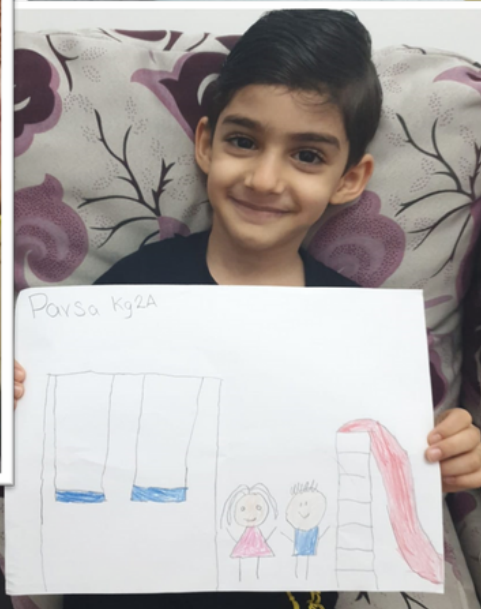
